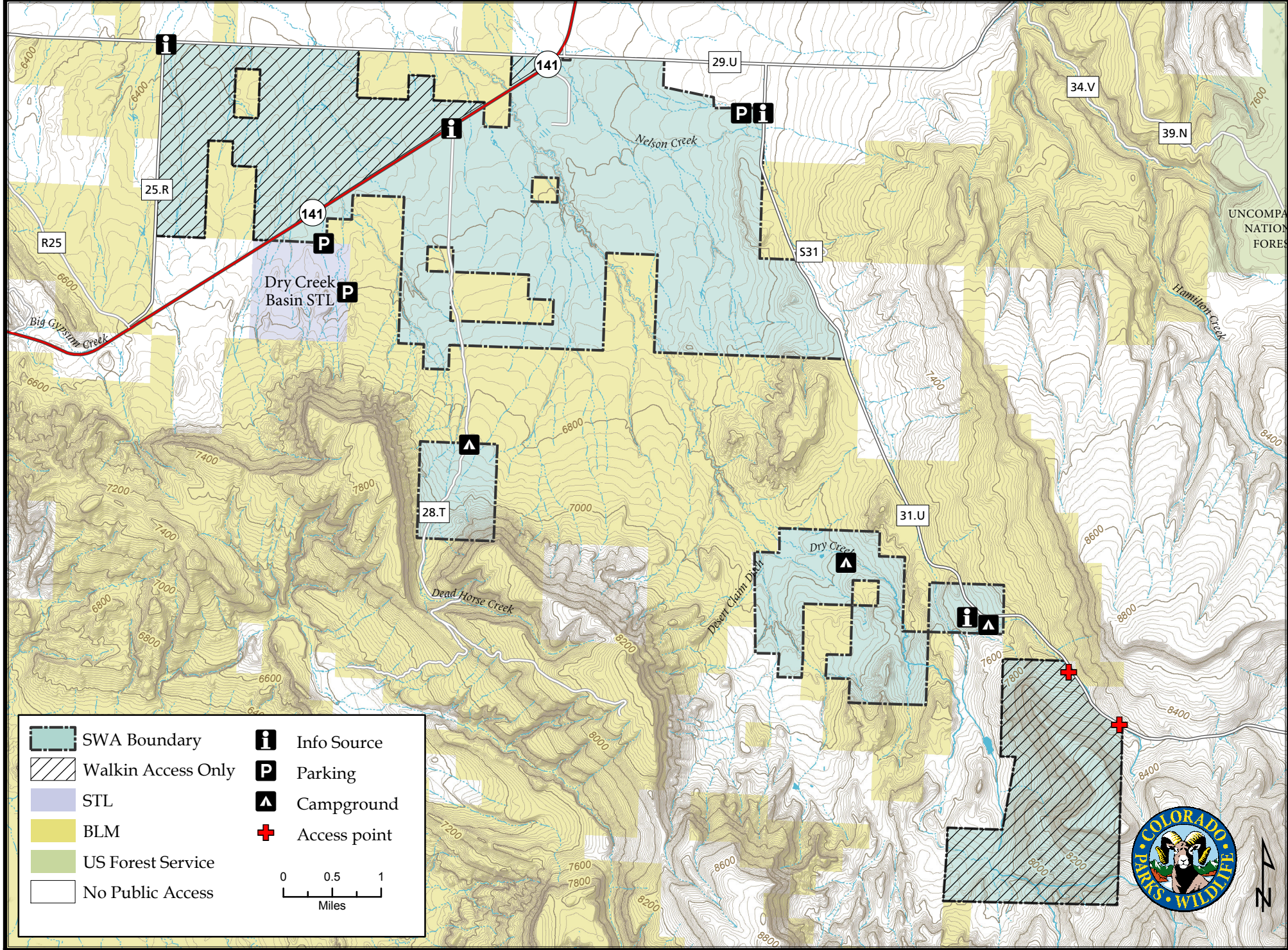
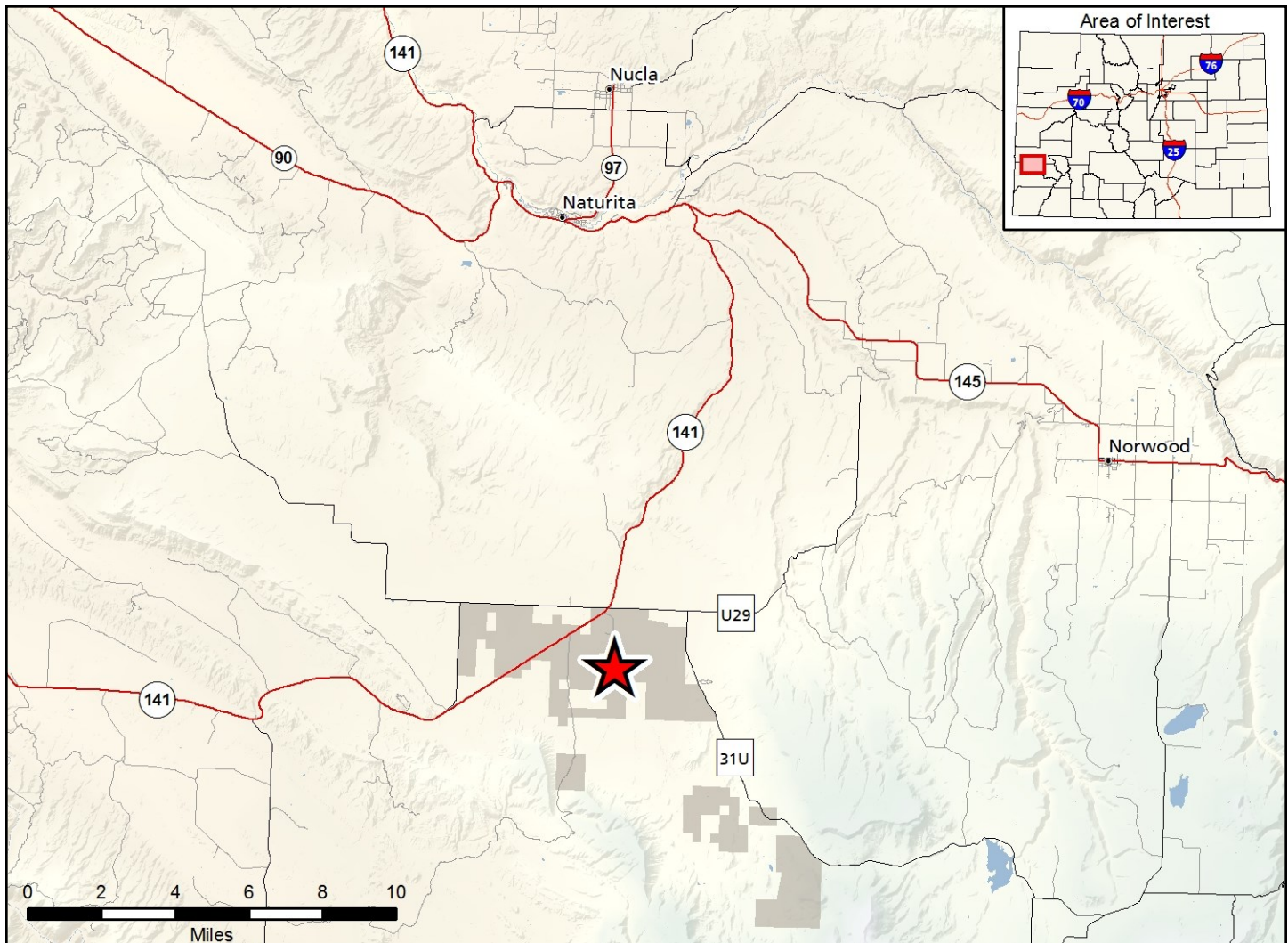


Dry Creek Basin State Wildlife Area

Dry Creek Basin SWA - San Miguel County

From Naturita, go 3 miles east on Highway 145 to Highway 141, then approximately 13 miles south (right) to the main body of the property. To reach the more remote southeastern tract, go 11 miles south on Highway 141 to County Road U29, then 2 miles east (left) to County Road 31U, and then 6 miles south (right) to the access road and parking area on the right.

Wildlife Area Offers:

Hunting: Deer, elk, rabbit, dove, mountain lion, bobcat, coyote

Recreation: Wildlife viewing

Regulations:

In addition to those restrictions listed in regulation #900 the below listed provisions or restrictions apply (see Chapter 9, <http://cpw.state.co.us/aboutus/Pages/Regulations.aspx>).

- A. Snowmobile use is prohibited.
- B. Camping is allowed in designated areas by licensed hunters during an established big game season plus three (3) days before and three (3) days after each season.
