General Information: From Loveland, go 2 miles west on First Street to County Road 21, then 1/2 mile south to the reservoir. Boedecker is wakeless lake with a concrete boat ramp and parking on the northeast side of the lake. When the lake is full it contains several submerged grass and brush piles along the western shores.

Sportfishing Notes

<u>Walleye</u> •Fish any rock structure when water temps are 45-55°F. •Later, fish are scattered but tube jigs, lindy rigs, triple ripples, are good choices.

White Bass


Follow the birds! The white bass will be chasing shad!
Use silver castmasters or another shad imitation.
Often attracted to flows when the reservoir is filling (especially at 60-65°F).
