


Lean Process (2017)

- Improve public involvement
- Set # plan completions/revisions needed per year

Proposed Timeline: All Plans Up to Date by 2026

- >200 plans require updating every 10 years
- With 2-Step Approval Process, >40 presentations every year
- Need 2X this rate to "catch up" by 2026




