ISSUE: Should CPW add additional camping types to update and clarify fees? DISCUSSION (FACTS AND FIGURES, EXPLANATION OF ISSUE):

Currently, there are four camping site types and ten cabin/yurt site types in P-7 regulations. Splitting out the site types would better reflect the reality of park facilities. This will allow us to better represent the sites in the system and clarify the process for customers and staff.

The two additional camping types we would like to add are as follows:

- Add "Tent-Only Campgrounds" with a maximum fee that aligns to "Electrical Campgrounds" at \$36.00/night. This proposed fee is based on some tent-only sites having electrical hookups.
- Add "Tipi" with a maximum fee of \$50.00/night. This proposed fee is based on a tipi being smaller than a yurt or cabin with fewer amenities.

Camping Customers: This is an administrative clean up to clarify changes for customers and has no major impact.

Staff: Staff has asked for more defined facilities to align with what exists on-park.

1. ***Preferred Alternative*:** Add the two new site types and fees, as proposed above to Chapter P-07 #708.4-7.

"Tent-Only Campground" will be defined as allowing only tents as the camping equipment. However, they many have amenities similar to "Electric Campgrounds" or "Basic Campgrounds" depending on the facility.
