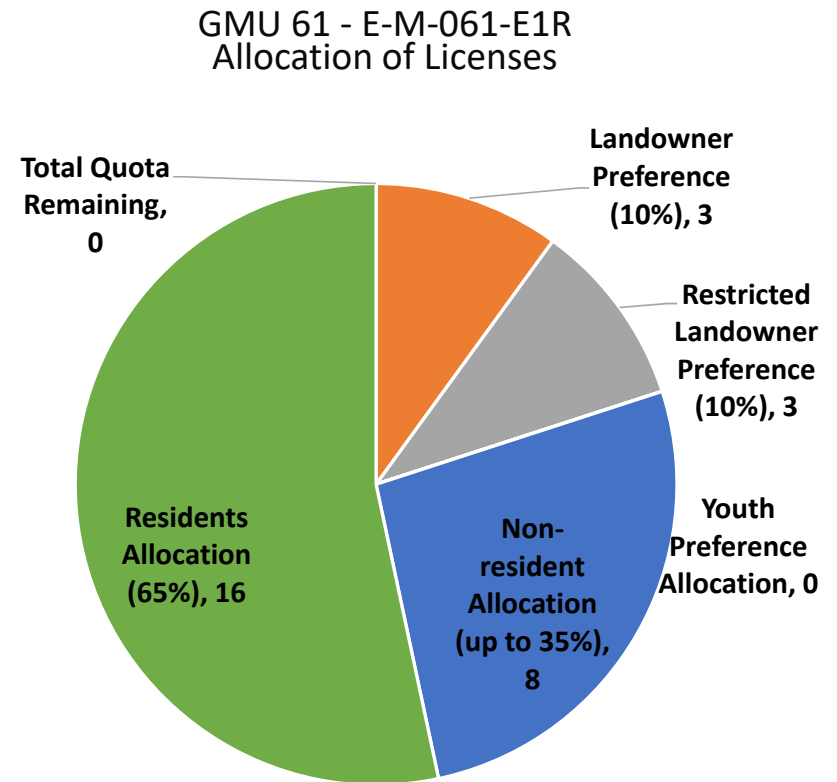

Possible resident/nonresident allocation method changes for 2021 limited license draw

- Option 1: Update the years to 2018, 2019, 2020 and maintain 6+ preference-point threshold
- Option 2: Update the years to 2018, 2019, 2020 and increase preference-point threshold to 8+ points
- Option 3: Designate certain high-demand Game Management Units
- Option 4: Maintain status quo





Resident/Nonresident Allocation

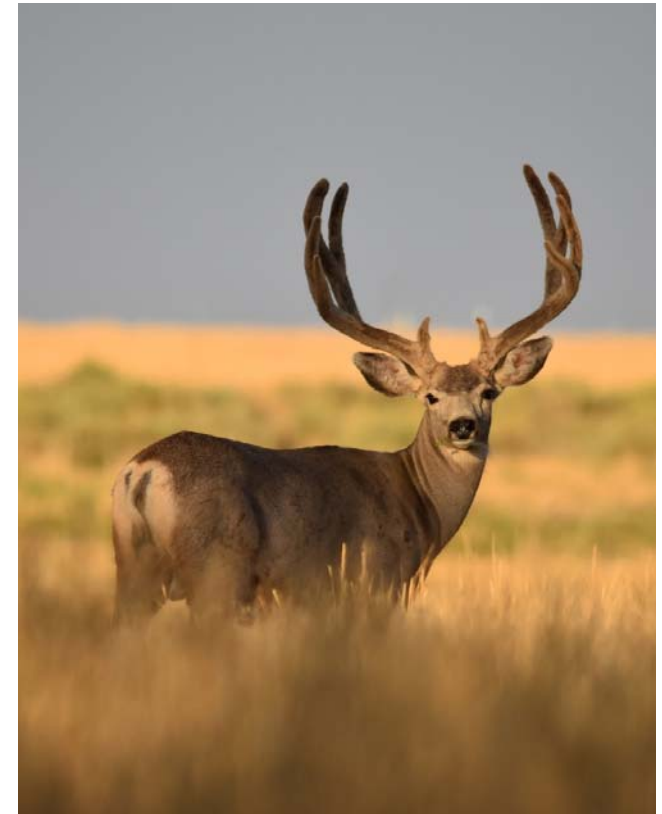
- Current regulation
 - Hunt codes for deer and elk that required ≥ 6 preference points on average for the 2007-2009 seasons
 - 80:20 allocation
 - 65:35 allocation



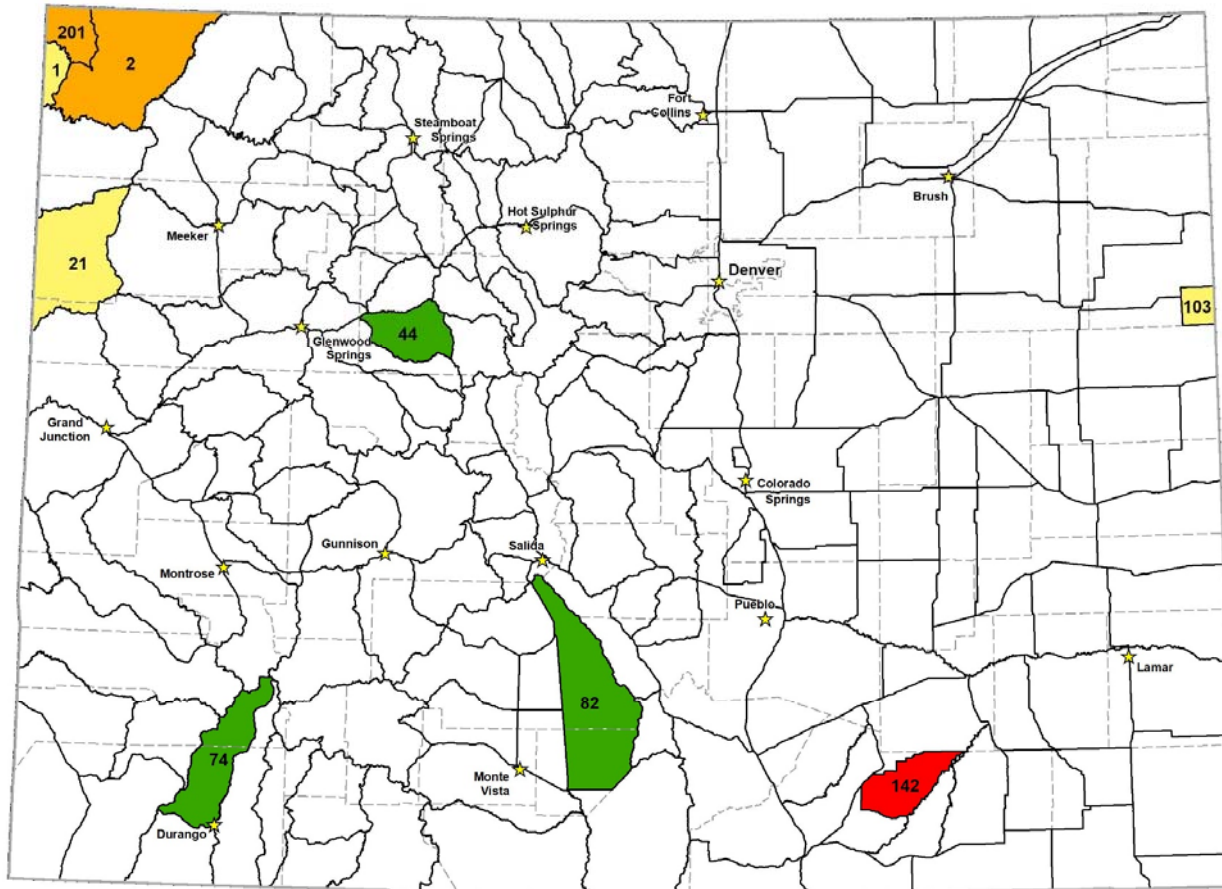
Resident/Nonresident Allocation

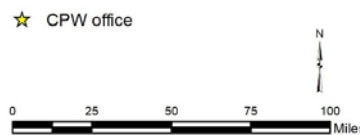
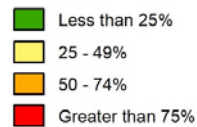


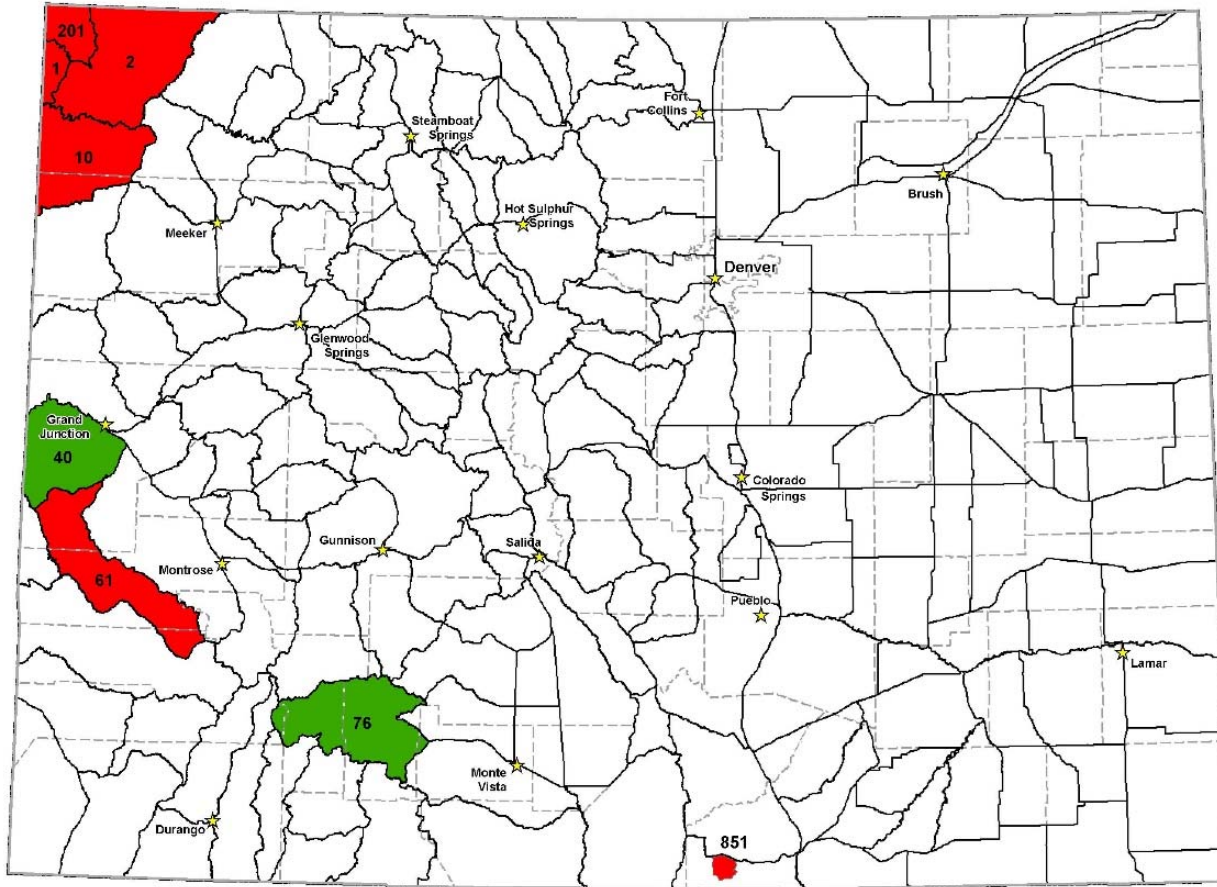

2007-2009

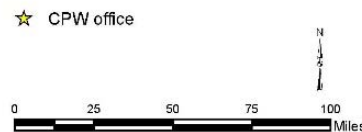
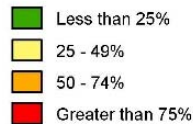


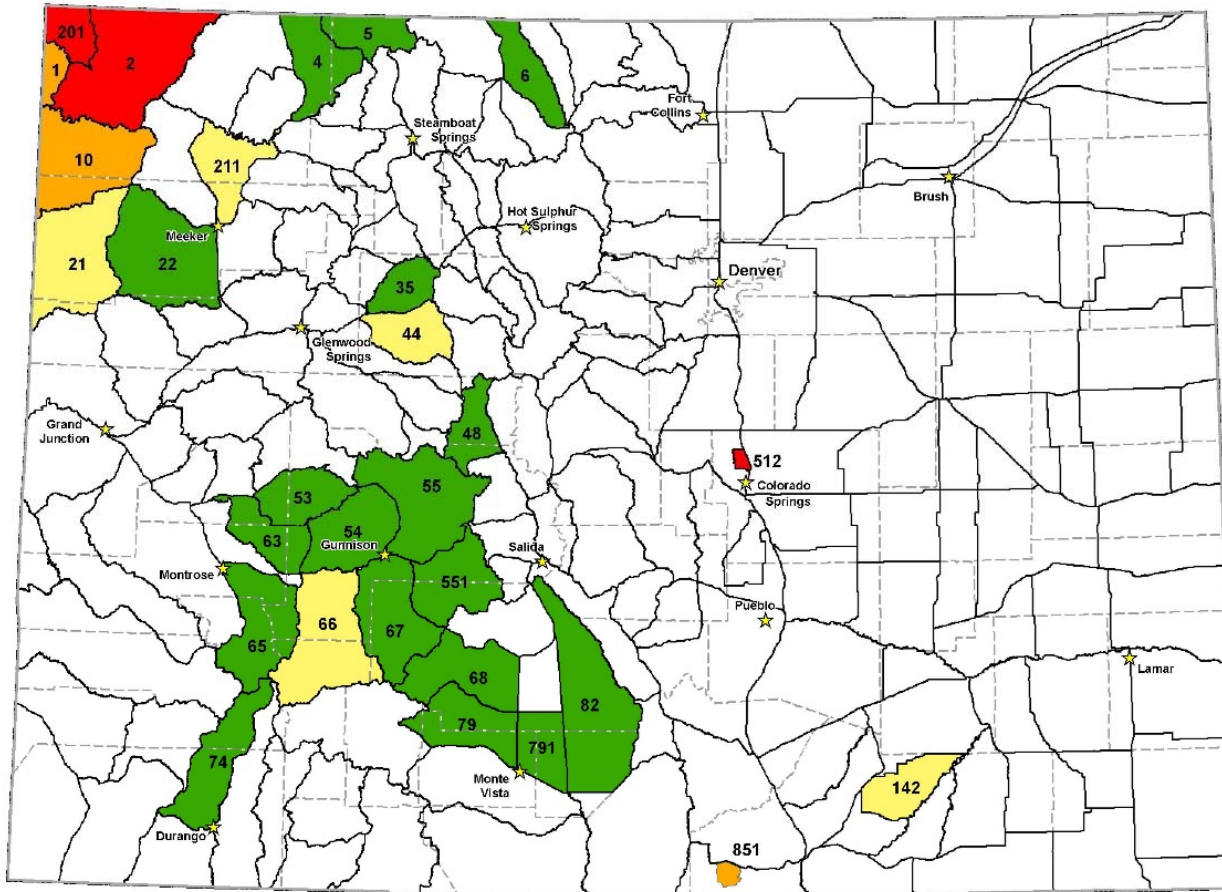

2007-2009



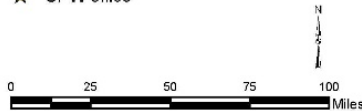


Proportion of Male and Either-Sex Deer Huntcodes by GMU Requiring 6+ Preference Points Update for 2018-2020

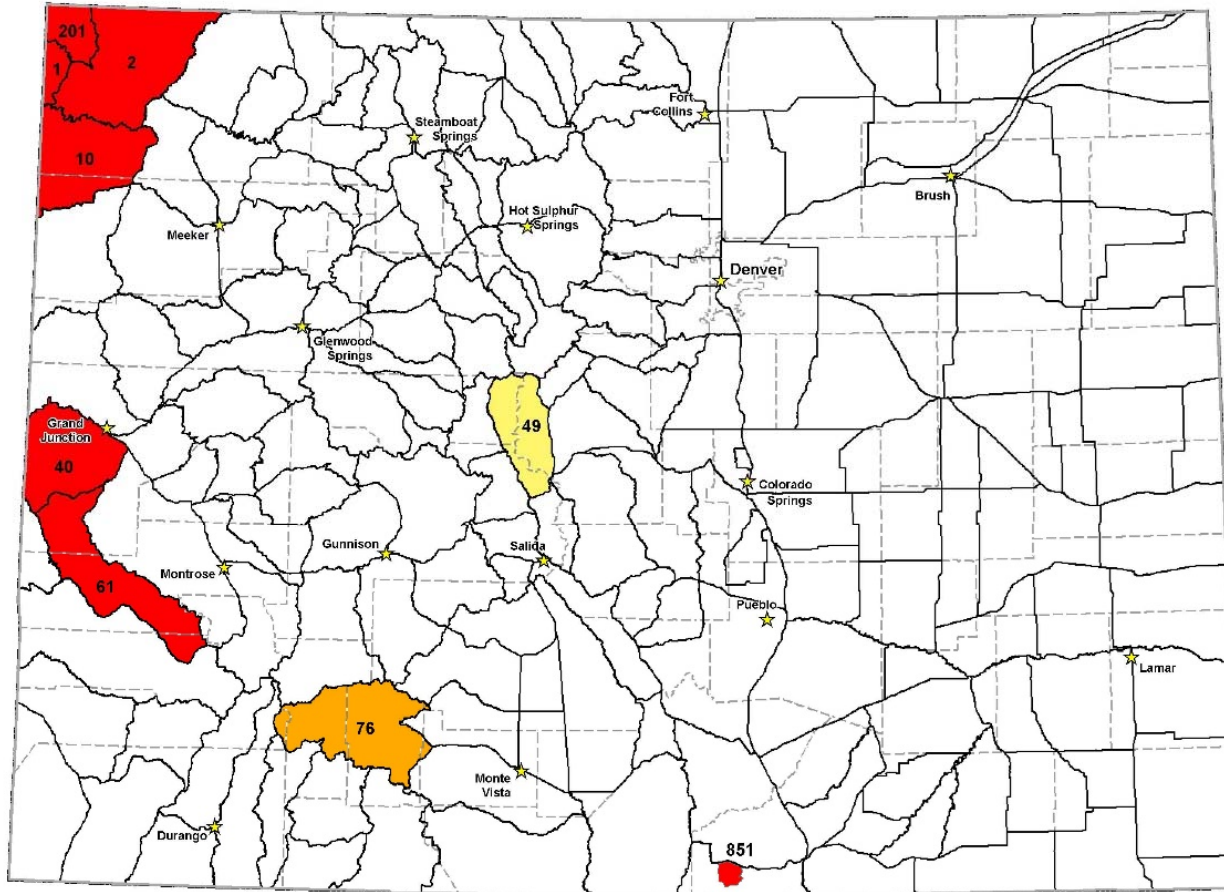

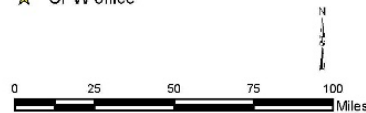


Proportion of Male and Either-Sex Elk Huntcodes by GMU Requiring 6+ Preference Points Update for 2018-2020

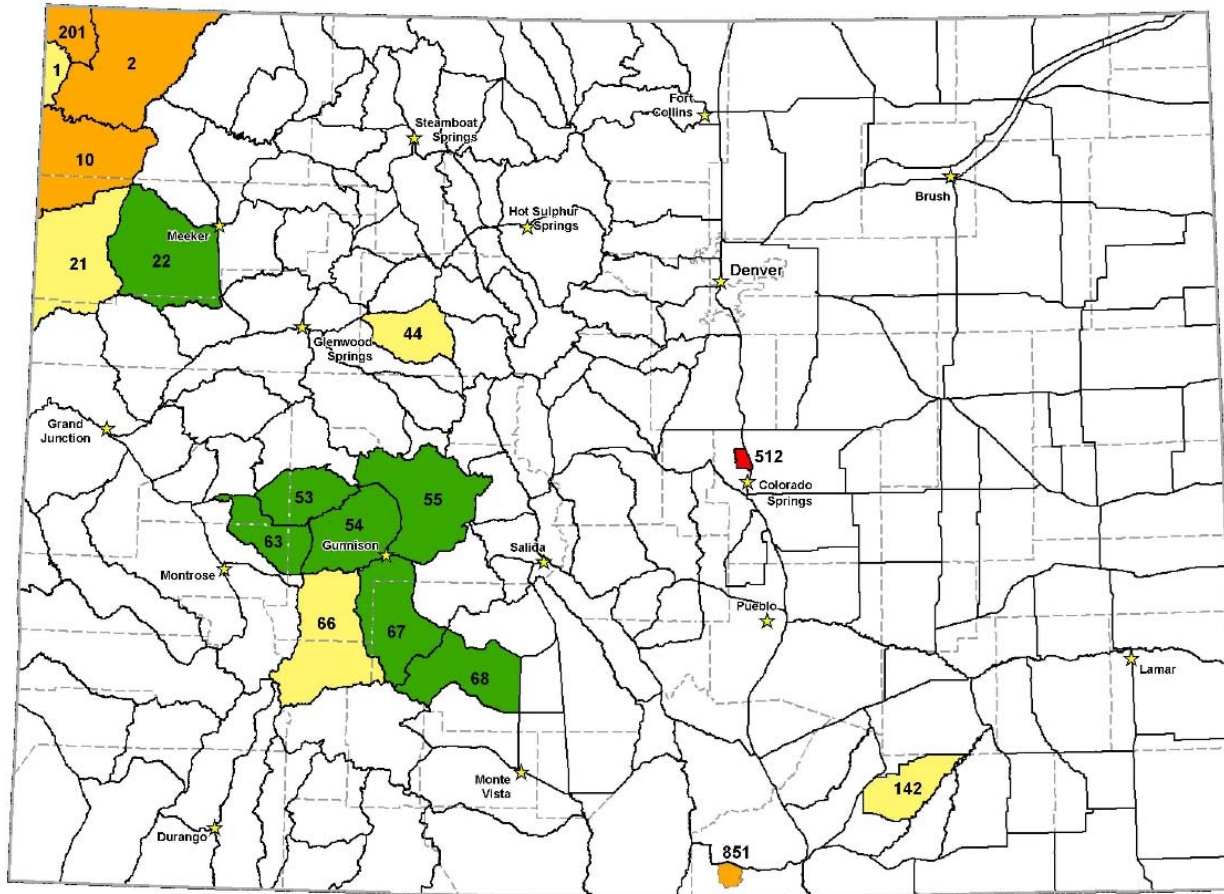

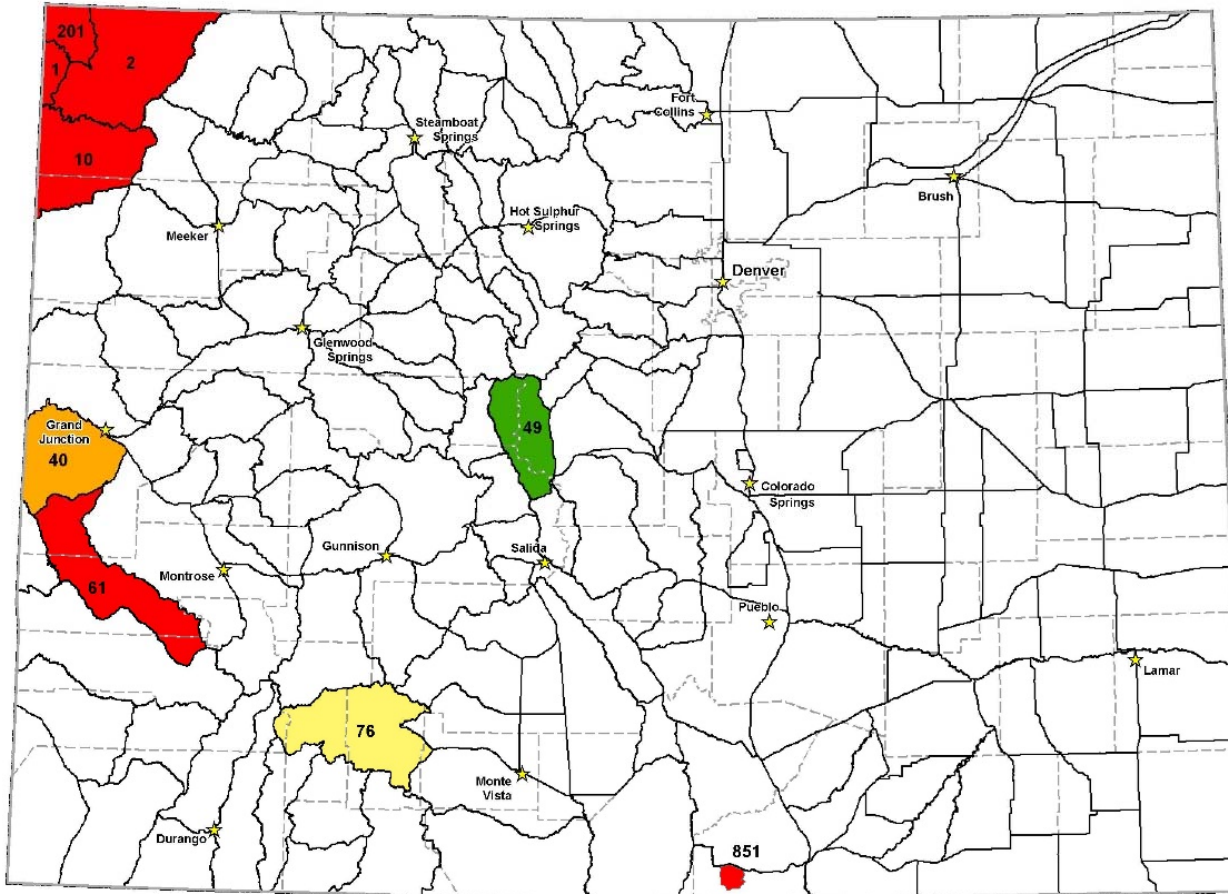

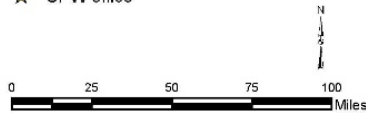


Proportion of Male and Either-Sex

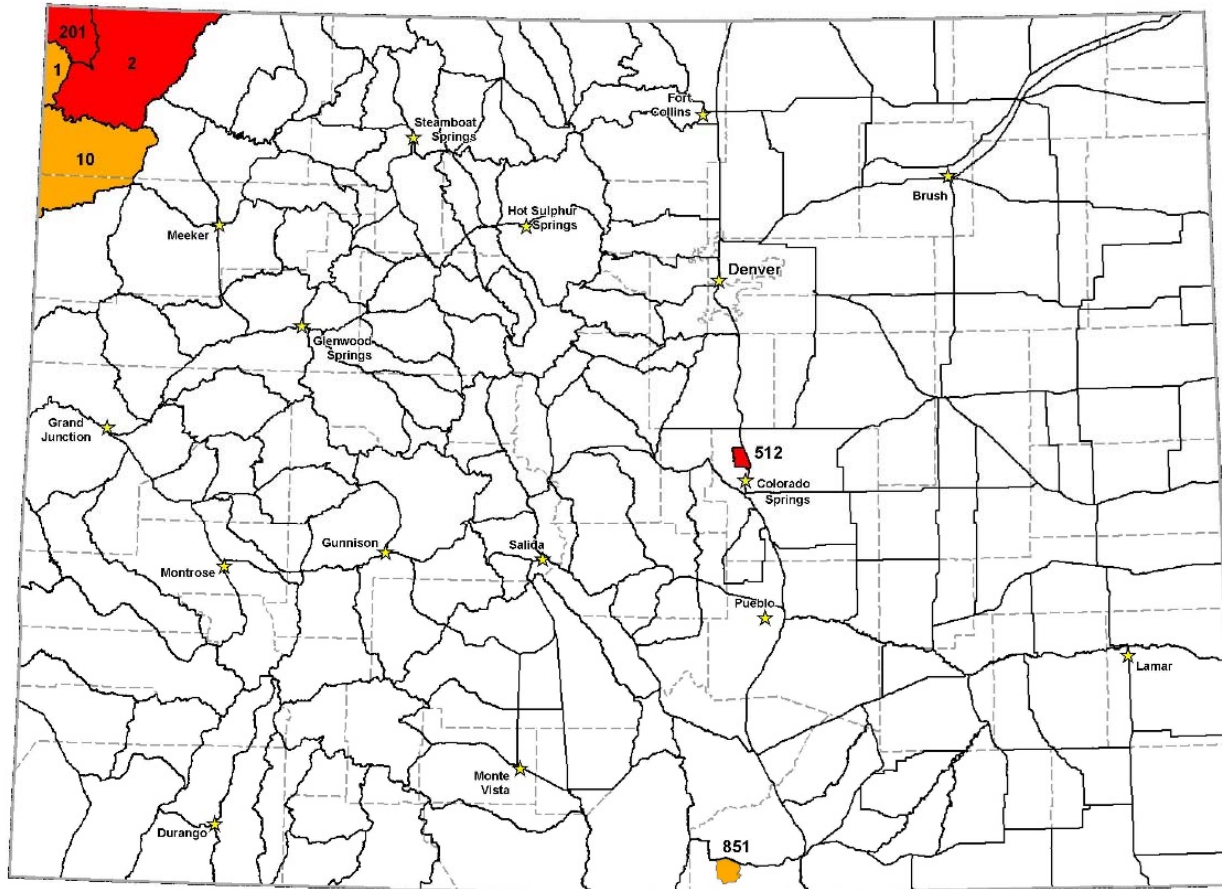

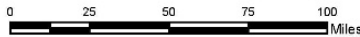


Proportion of Male and Either-Sex Deer Huntcodes by GMU Unit Approach Update for 2018-2020

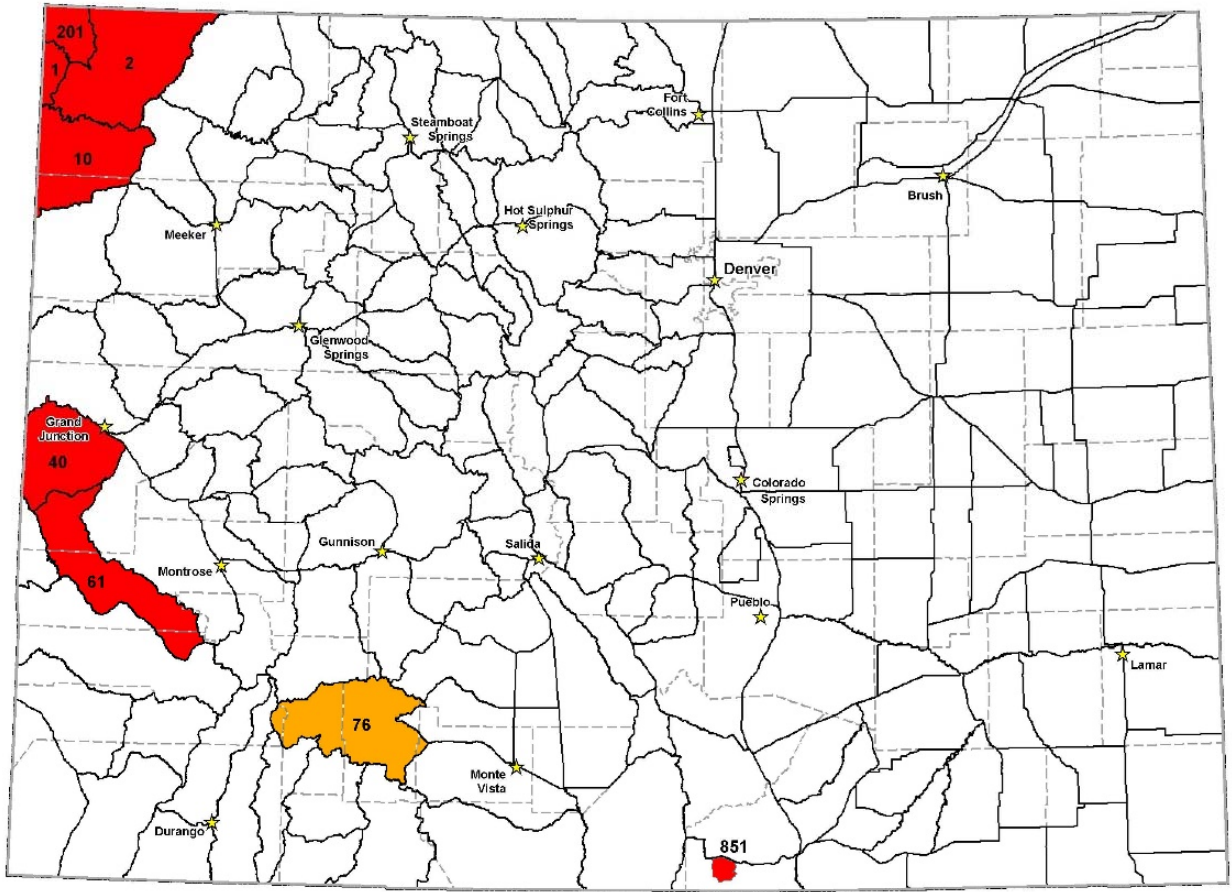

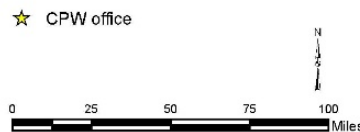
Option #3: GMU Approach 80/20 List Deer (2018-2020)
