ISSUE: Should Fishers Peak State Park regulations be changed for consistency with CPW's			
recommended seasonal restrictions for Colorado raptors?			
DISCUSSION (FACTS AND FIGURES, EXPLANATION OF ISSUE):			
The 19,200-acre Fishers Peak State Park (FPSP) is located south of the City of Trinidad in Las Animas County, Colorado, and is CPW's newest state park. Initial park-specific regulations were established in 2020, prior to the park's limited public opening in October of 2020. Since that time, the need for a regulation edit has come to our attention.			
The peregrine falcon nest buffer closure for FPSP is currently March 15 - July 15 in regulations. However, in Colorado Parks and Wildlife's Recommended Buffer Zones and Seasonal Restrictions for Colorado Raptors, the recommended dates for peregrine falcon nest buffer closures are March 15 - July 31. For consistency with the CPW's recommended raptor guidelines, we are asking the Parks and Wildlife Commission (PWC) to extend the closure date for the peregrine falcon nest buffer to July 31 <sup>st</sup> annually.
