Option A:

Consideration of allocation/preference point changes in conjunction with Big Game Attitude Survey (BGAS)

- July Nov 2021 interim measures (if identified) through 2-3 step regulatory process
- Nov Dec 2021 focus groups to inform BGAS
- Feb Apr 2022 implement BGAS
- June July 2022 BGAS results & stakeholder outreach
- July Aug 2022 draft recommendations
- Sept Nov 2022 presentation & adoption of regulations through 2-step process



Option B: Phased approach with stakeholder workgroup

- May 2021 applications for stakeholder workgroup
- June 2021 2-3 virtual meetings with workgroup
- June Aug 2021 draft recommendations
- Sept Nov 2021

presentation & adoption of regulations through 2-step process
