The first quarter of fiscal year 2021-22 ended on September 31st. With the accounting period fully closing after the third week of October, this meeting is the first chance to review Q1 data. What we see at the top line totals is both revenue and expense increasing over the same quarter a year ago, however there is some detail to these changes that is worth exploring. Revenue from licenses and passes is down somewhat substantially though this is more than offset by General Fund and Severance Tax revenue increases due to recent legislation. Looking into the year over year change in license and pass revenue it turns out that the entry of earned revenue into the states accounting system has fallen behind due to staffing issues. When looking at the detailed revenue information you will see that the "reconcile to general ledger" line shows some substantial reductions due to period three (September) revenue not being entered until period four (October). The next quarterly reporting should correct this timing difference and, based on rough calculations, revenues from licenses and passes should be roughly on par year over year.

Moving to the expense side of the ledger we also see some mixed results. Personal services and operating expenses are up but offset by decreases in payments to other agencies (this includes such things as CORE, legal services, OIT, and indirect cost payments). The majority of the increased expense cost is due to capital acquisitions which vary from year to year due to the timing of project closings. All in all, CPW continues to have revenues in excess of expense.

On November 1 the Governor submitted his annual budget request to the legislature for consideration during the upcoming legislative session. Specific increses for Colorado Parks and Wildlife includes operating spending authority for state parks, operating and staff increases for the wildlife side of the agency, Colorado Outdoor Regional Partnerships, the Wildlife Council, as well as some other more technical changes. The Capital Budget request, submitted at an earlier date but considered on the same timeline, notable included a much increased Wildlife large capital program and a substantial request for hatchery modernization.
