No physical pass required for Colorado registered vehicles that opt in on their registration.* All Colorado plated vehicles that opt in are permitted access to all State Parks. Vehicle registration is used to prove compliance as needed or requested.

2021 State Park Pass Descriptions




DEC 21
Vehicle Annual Affixed Pass \$80/each
 Provides entrance to all state parks for everyone in the vehicle. The vehicle license plate number must be provided when purchasing. Annual pass is valid beginning on the date of purchase and through the last day of the same month in the following year.


Multiple Affixed \$40/each
 Vehicle Annual Affixed or Family Annual Pass holders may purchase a discounted Multiple pass for additional vehicles registered to the pass owner or any person living in the same household as the pass holder. Vehicle registration is required as proof. The Multiple pass expiration month is the same as printed on the original Vehicle Annual or Family Annual pass purchased. Multiples are for noncommercial vehicles only.


DEC 21
Aspen Leaf Annual Affixed & Aspen Leaf Multiple Pass Annual: \$70 Multiple: \$35/each
 Must be a Colorado resident and at least 64 years old at the time of purchase. A Colorado vehicle registration to the pass holder's name and Colorado driver's license or ID must be provided when purchasing. Aspen Leaf Annual pass is valid beginning on the date of purchase and through the last day of the same month in the following year. The senior must be in the vehicle to enter the park. Aspen Leaf pass holders receive discounted camping rates valid Tuesday-Thursday, excluding federal holidays. Aspen Leaf Multiples may be purchased for additional vehicles owned by the Aspen Leaf pass holder. The expiration month of Aspen Leaf Multiple is the same as printed on the original Aspen Leaf Annual pass purchased. Aspen Leaf passes are for noncommercial vehicles only.


New!
Family Annual Pass \$120/each
 This transferable pass is issued to an individual, not a vehicle. Anyone living at the same address as the pass holder can use the pass in their vehicle as long as the same address on their legal form of ID matches the pass holder. Organizations/companies cannot purchase this pass.





Notes: Vehicle Annual, Aspen Leaf Annual and Multiple passes must be attached to the lower right corner of vehicle windshield. Application not for those desiring an older pass as it will not be renewed. The top portion of the annual pass may be shown to the pass holder as an individual Daily Pass at applicable parks. When receiving Cherry Creek, the senior Citizen's Credit from West Valley Quality Authority for a \$100 or \$150.


Daily Parks Pass Daily: \$9-\$10 per vehicle

 This pass is good for one-day and expires at noon the next day. This pass does not guarantee re-entry in your vehicle when the park has reached visitation capacity.


Individual Daily Pass Individual Daily Pass \$4 per day or use the upper panels of your annual pass for entry.

 Applies to any person entering a state park except Doud Lake, Chatfield, Cherry Creek, Cheyenne Mountain and Lake Park, unless in a motor vehicle with a valid annual or daily pass.

Commercial Bus Daily Pass

 Free (based on # of people in the vehicle)
 Vehicle Carrying:
 1-15 people: \$10
 16-30: \$ 40
 31 & up: \$ 50
 Expires at 12 noon the next day.

Towed Vehicle Pass

 No fee and valid the same dates as the camping reservation. Affix to lower right inside of vehicle windshield.

Colorado Disabled Veterans License Plate

Admitted Free
 No vehicle pass shall be required for any resident's vehicle displaying a Colorado Disabled Veteran's License Plate. Veterans must be in the vehicle. Available from Colorado Department of Motor Vehicles.

Self-Serve Kiosk Park Entrance Pass

 Annual passes purchased at self-serve park kiosks are a temporary pass valid for 30-days only. In order to obtain your permanent annual pass, the pass receipt must be exchanged within 30 days of purchase at a CPWV office or park. Receipts are non-refundable and non-replaceable; treat them like cash.

Library Pass-Free

 Available from your local Colorado public library for check-out.

Camping Reservations
 Many state parks offer campsites, cabins and yurts for overnight stays. Advance reservations can be made 6 months before and up through the day of arrival.

Special Passes
 Issued to individuals and not a specific vehicle. The Blue Spruce, Centennial, Columbine, Independence, Military and/or Volunteer pass is transferable from motor vehicle to motor vehicle as long as the pass holder is present in the vehicle. The passes below are valid for 12 months from the date of purchase, except the Centennial and Military passes.

Centennial Pass \$14
 (Limited Income CO resident)
 Valid until March 31 each year.

DEC 21
Columbine Pass \$14
 (Disabled CO resident)

DEC 21
Independence Pass-Free
 (Disabled First Responders/CO resident-only)

DEC 21
Blue Spruce Pass-Free
 (Disabled First Responders/CO resident-only)

DEC 21
Dog Off-Leash Area Passes \$25/yr or \$10/day
 (Cherry Creek and Chatfield only, 5 AM-10 PM)
 Use of the Dog Off-Leash Area (DOLA) requires a valid DOLA pass and a valid park pass for all vehicles entering the park, but the passes do not guarantee entry when the area has reached visitation capacity. Handlers may leave up to three dogs under their control.

DEC 21
Volunteer Pass
 Volunteers are eligible for the pass after 40 hours of service during a consecutive 12-month period. Passes only issued through a park manager or volunteer coordinator.

AUG 21
Military Pass-Free
 Active duty military and veterans are admitted free with this pass. Only available August 1-31.
