

- 40% of anglers fished at State Parks
















Challenges at Colorado Hatcheries

AGING INFRASTRUCTURE

- Many hatcheries are
 70+ years old
- Older buildings are costly and inefficient
- Concrete raceways cracking and leaking and very expensive to repair
- Current system cannot keep up with growing angler demand
