The state's fiscal year ended on June 30th, three weeks ago, but closing the financial books will still take significant time. I hope to bring end-of-year financials to you at your September meeting. In the meantime, I did receive a couple of questions at the last commission meeting. In reviewing the more detailed information which forms the basis of the Commission Report Commissioner Adams noted that \$2.4 million was being shown as "bank fees." A look at further detailed reports reveals that the vast majority of that amount is credit card fees that we pay when some pays us with a credit card.
