

**COLORADO Parks and Wildlife** Department of Natural Resources

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#### Commissioners

Included in this mailing is the second quarter Commission Report for financial activity through December 31<sup>st</sup>, of 2022. You may notice some changes to the layout as the report is going through a transition. Notably, in the current report, we are showing five years of data for the revenue detail. Overall, expenses through the first half of the year are more-or-less flat, with \$3 million less revenue being earned and \$3 million more expenses being realized.

On the revenue side of the equation there is a slight decrease in revenue from licenses, passes, fees, and permits (\$3 million / 2.7%). There is a more significant declines in federal revenues (4.8 million / ~25%) but most of our federal grants are reimbursable, which means that there should be a commiserate decrease in expenses. There is a significant decrease in General Fund support that is offset by an increase in Severance Tax revenues which is attributable to the recovery of the Severance Tax fund, and renewed transfers to the agency from that fund, which are no longer being backfilled by the General Fund.

On the expense side we see significant growth in personal services (\$5.8 million / 10%) and operating (\$5.5 million / 20.5%) reflecting an increase in available resources to cost centers and the associated increase in operations. This is offset by a reduction in the capital program (\$11.7 million / 38%) primarily due to the variable nature of real estate acquisitions. Overall, revenue exceeded expenses by \$52.6 million in the first half of the year.

Looking separately at the Parks and Wildlife sides of the agency there is additional detail available. Though there is a reduction in the sale of park products (\$1.3 million / 5.8%) the large reductions are in Federal Grants (\$5.2 million / 76%) related to the one-time acquisition of Colorado Clays and in General Fund (\$5.6 million / 85%) related to one-time transfers. In park expenses, personal services and operating are in line with the department, while capital expenditures were skewed by Colorado Clays. The wildlife side of the agency that are largely in line with the overall results.

If we compare volumes across years (as opposed to revenue) a picture of product sales returning to previous levels emerges. Parks annual passes are down compared to pandemic levels but remain high compared to historic levels while vehicle daily passes have fully returned to historic levels. Both pass types are likely to change drastically in the upcoming reports. Encouragingly, camping took off substantially in FY 2019-20 and remains high. The sale of big game licenses shows a noticeable reduction in resident elk sales while other species and residency combinations show roughly flat sales. The sale of fishing licenses has come off of historic highs and are below pre-pandemic levels.
