




Figure 2. Historical range and current range of the gray wolf (*Canis lupus*) in the lower 48 United States.

Colorado Revised Statute 33-2-105.8

- The Commission shall...
- Restore wolves west of the Continental Divide
- Develop methodology for determining when the gray wolf is sustaining itself
- Resolve conflicts with those involved in ranching and farming
- Take steps necessary to begin reintroductions by December 31, 2023


