


LOTTERY PROCEED

BENEFICIARIES

- > 10% to Colorado state parks
- ➤ 40% to the Conservation Trust Fund
- Up to 50% to GOCO against a constitutionally mandated cap adjusted for inflation each year.

Once the cap is met, surplus funds go to the Outdoor Equity Fund, Building Excellent Schools Today (BEST), and CPW again.
