POLICY STATEMENT

The Colorado Wildlife Commission's intention is to distribute licenses in a reasonable manner. Recognizing the desirability and restricted number of desert bighorn sheep, Rocky Mountain bighorn sheep, mountain goat, and moose licenses the Commission will allocate at a statewide level no more than 10 percent of the total number of licenses to nonresidents. It is the intent of the Commission to allocate 10 percent of these licenses to nonresidents, and to distribute these by sex, method of take and geographical area. The Commission recognizes that since these licenses are few in number, some hunt codes may exceed 10% and rounding of licenses may be necessary. In these cases, rounding will be to the benefit of resident sportsmen.
