

SNOWY PINE CONE TREES



Winter often brings snow to Colorado, covering the landscape in a beautiful white blanket. Trees look especially nice when covered in a snowy coat, and now you can make your very own! Using just a few simple supplies, create a snowy pine cone tree to bring the beauty of winter indoors.

You can make just one tree, or a whole forest! Have fun and be creative; use white and silver glitter for winter trees, green glitter for summer trees, or orange and yellow glitter for fall trees.

Materials

- Pine cones gathered from outdoors
- Craft glue
- White or silver glitter Small flowerpot Ribbon
- Paintbrush
- Newspaper

Instructions

1. Place the newspaper on the floor or table to keep the area clean.
2. Use the paintbrush to brush glue on the pine cone and sprinkle it with glitter.
3. Paint glue on the inside rim of the flower pot and place the pine cone inside, hold it in place for one minute or until the glue is dry.
4. Tie a ribbon around the flowerpot and glue in place.
5. Display your winter pine cone tree for everyone to see!
