CREATE A SOLAR PRINT



Let the hot summer sun do most of the work and create your very own solar print, using the power of sunlight.

Materials:

- Colored construction paper
- Tape
- Plastic wrap
- Objects from nature (flowers, leaves, sticks, rocks, grass, pinecones, etc.)



Instructions:

- 1. Find a bright sunny spot and tape a piece of construction paper to the ground. Make sure your location will have sun for the entire day.
- 2. Collect 8-10 different natural objects.
- 3. Arrange your natural objects on the paper however you'd like.
- 4. Tape the plastic wrap over your objects and the construction paper so wind won't blow your objects away.
- 5. Let your project enjoy the summer sun for a full day.
- 6. At the end of the day, peel back the plastic wrap and remove all of the nature items. Don't forget to return the nature objects to where your found them.
- 7. Enjoy your new art project!

Did different objects leave different colored marks? Which object left the darkest mark? What would happen if you pulled some of the objects sooner?
