TO BE CONSIDERED AS A RECORD FISH BY WEIGHT FOR COLORADO IN ANY OF THE ABOVE CATEGORIES:

- 1 Fish must be taken by legal angling methods from Colorado waters. Angler must have been correctly following all applicable angling regulations and licensing requirements at the time of catch.
- 2 Fish may have been caught in either public or private fishing waters.
- 3 Fish **MUST BE KEPT** in order to qualify.
- 4 An official entry form must be used. Photograph of fish on scale, photograph of fish on a length measuring device, and signed receipt of weight must accompany entry. Weight should be taken before fish is frozen and on a scale which has been certified by the State of Colorado to be accurate within one ounce (meat market, produce, grocery scales).
- 5 Entry must be accompanied by signature of one person (no relatives) who witnessed weighing and measuring. After weighing, the fish may be iced, but not frozen, filleted or otherwise cut up. It must be available for inspection and identification by Division personnel before being frozen and before an entry form is submitted.
