2023 KOKANEE REGULATIONS

Statewide kokanee limit by angling or snagging: 10 daily bag & possession

Barker Reservoir - Boulder County

Snagging for kokanee salmon is permitted from October 1 through December 1.

Beaver Creek Reservoir - Rio Grande County

Snagging for kokanee salmon is permitted from October 1 through December 31.

Blue Mesa Reservoir - Gunnison County

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from November 1 through December 31. **K**okanee daily bag limit is 5 fish, possession limit is 10 fish

Blue River – Grand and Summit Counties

From the Colo. 9 bridge over the Blue River at Blue River State Wildlife Area downstream to the Green Mountain Reservoir inlet:
Snagging for kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

<u>Cheesman Reservoir - Douglas and</u> <u>Jefferson Counties</u>

Snagging of kokanee is permitted from September 1 through September 30.

Cimarron River - Montrose County

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from November 1 through December 31.

Clear Creek- Chaffee County

From the gauging station (approximately ½ mile above Clear Creek Reservoir) downstream to Clear Creek Reservoir: Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from October 1 through December 31.

Clear Creek Reservoir- Chaffee County

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from October 1 through December 31.

Colorado River, (North Fork) including Shadow Mountain Spillway – Grand County

From Shadow Mountain Dam spillway to Lake Granby including Columbine Bay to the Twin Creek inlet:

Fishing is prohibited from October 15 through November 30.

<u>Crystal Reservoir - Montrose County</u>

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

<u>Dolores River – Dolores and</u> <u>Montezuma Counties</u>

From the confluence with the West Fork of the Dolores River downstream to the standing water line of McPhee Reservoir:
The taking of kokanee salmon is prohibited, except from November 15 through December 31, when snagging is permitted.

East River - Gunnison County

1. From the upstream property boundary at the Roaring Judy Fish Hatchery downstream to the confluence with the Taylor River:
The taking of kokanee salmon is prohibited.

2. From Roaring Judy Hatchery outlet downstream to the Roaring Judy property boundary:

Fishing is prohibited from August 1 through October 31.

Florida River - LaPlata County

From the headwaters downstream to Lemon Reservoir:

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

Lake Granby – Grand County

- 1. From January 1 through August 31, the bag and possession limit for trout (except lake trout) and kokanee salmon is four fish, singly or in aggregate.
- 2. From September 1 through December 31, the bag and possession limit for kokanee salmon is 10 fish.
- 3. Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted September 1 through December 31 except snagging is prohibited in Columbine Bay from the inlet of Twin Creek upstream.

<u>Green Mountain Reservoir - Grand and Summit Counties</u>

Snagging for kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

Grimes Creek - LaPlata County

From the Bureau of Reclamation property downstream to the standing water line of Vallecito Reservoir:

- 1. Fishing is prohibited from September 1 through November 14.
- 2. Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from November 15 through December 31.

Gross Reservoir - Boulder County

- 1. Fishing is prohibited from sunset to sunrise.
- 2. Snagging for kokanee is permitted from October 1 through December 1.

<u>Gunnison River - Delta, Gunnison and</u> Montrose counties

- 1. From the confluence of the East and Taylor Rivers downstream to the standing water line of Blue Mesa Reservoir, including all tributary canals and diversions:
- a. The taking of kokanee salmon is prohibited from August 1 through October 31.b. Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted November 1 through December 31.

<u>Gunnison River - Delta, Gunnison and</u> <u>Montrose counties (continued)</u>

- 2. From the closure signs below Blue Mesa Dam downstream to Morrow Point Res. Dam: Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.
- 3. From the closure sign below Morrow Point Reservoir dam downstream to Crystal Reservoir Dam:

Snagging of kokanee is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

<u>Gunnison River, Lake Fork - Gunnison</u> <u>and Hinsdale counties</u>

From the upper Red Bridge campground boundary downstream to Blue Mesa Res.: Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

McPhee Reservoir - Montezuma County

Snagging for kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

<u>Monument Reservoir - Las Animas</u> <u>County</u>

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from October 1 through December 31.

Morrow Point Reservoir - Gunnison and Montrose Counties

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted September 1 through December 31.

Ridgway Reservoir - Ouray County

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

<u>Taylor Park Reservoir - Gunnison</u> County

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

Uncompangre River - Ouray County

From the Ouray CR 23 bridge downstream to Ridgway Reservoir:

Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.

<u>Vallecito Creek - La Plata and San Juan</u> Counties

- 1. From the southern boundary of the Weminuche Wilderness downstream to the standing water line of Vallecito Reservoir:
- a. All kokanee salmon must be returned to the water immediately upon catch from September 1 through November 14.
- b. Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from November 15 through December 31.

Williams Fork Reservoir - Grand County

- 1. Snagging of kokanee salmon is permitted from September 1 through December 31.
- 2. From the buoy line at the Williams Fork River inlet upstream to the first Grand County Road bridge:

Fishing and snagging are prohibited from September 15 to November 30.

<u>Wolford Mountain Reservoir - Grand</u> County

Public access, including fishing, is prohibited within 150 feet of any kokanee spawning trap or wing net from October 1 – December 1.

2023 Kokanee Giveaways

For youth to receive kokanee, they must be accompanied by a license holding adult. Up to 4 youth may receive fish with each licensed adult.
