

Rules and Regulations

1. All hunters must check in at the check in point before hunting. All hunters must check out at the end of the day. If the hunter is successful or not, he or she needs to fill out a hunter harvest report.
2. Hunting will not be allowed around any of the houses or ranch buildings. Certain areas will be closed for access due to cattle disturbance. Hunters will be notified of all closed areas at time of check in.
3. All hunters will be required to sign a release of liability form.
4. The ranch has two camping areas where camping is allowed. Absolutely no campfires for cooking or recreation, no open fires of any kind, no charcoal grills, no woodcutting, no construction of camp facilities, no blinds, no platforms, or no other structures.
5. No gathering artifacts, antler sheds, or removing any object from ranch.
6. No target shooting. All rifles should be sighted in prior to arrival at the ranch.
7. All vehicles must stay on established roads.
8. ATVs permitted off road only for retrieval of killed game.
9. No dogs, liquor, or illegal drugs allowed on the ranch.
- 10.No littering.
- 11.No fencing will be removed or cut; leave all gates as found.
- 12.No access to the ranch allowed unless you are participating in a current hunting season.
- 13.No killing of small game.
- 14.Hunting is walk in ONLY. Parking on the county road or specified fence lines and walk in access for hunting. A four wheeler or vehicle may only be used passed walk in points to retrieve game under direction of ranch management.
