## **Budget Report**

## **New Business**

## Sanderson Pipeline – Tanner Dutton

Tanner is asking HPP for \$4,500 for a contractor to bury pipeline on a new spring development. The development will include 3-4 water tanks and will improve livestock and wildlife distribution and decrease pressure on the adjacent riparian. This spring development will decrease damage to neighboring private agriculture lands and improve grazing distribution on public lands. HPP will be paying \$.45 per foot up to \$4,500 for the contractor to bury the pipeline. Permittee will be contributing \$500 for the tank hookup and installation as well as providing labor. Forest Service will be contributing \$2,000 for fittings, floats, plumbing parts, concrete, posts, wildlife escape ramps as well as providing labor. The Forest Service RAC will be contributing \$12,000 for the pipeline and tanks.

The project was approved for \$4,500.
