<u>Sporleder Ranch Conservation Easement – Brendan Boepple</u>

Brendan is asking the committee for \$5,000 to pay for fees including title research, closing costs, and mineral assessment for a conservation easement. The easement will include 798 acres of the Sporleder Ranch and will protect it from further defragmentation and development. The ranch provides habitat and forage for elk and deer throughout the year. Bob Holder (CPW District Wildlife Manager) has reviewed the project and submitted a statement of support, this was read to the committee. The Sporleder's will be donating the easement in its entirety.

The project was approved for \$5,000.
