

James M. Robb - Colorado River State Park, Pear Park - Mesa County

Take the Clifton/Hwy 141 exit from I-70. Go south and then southwest on I-170 B 3.4 miles until 30 Rd. Turn left on 30 Rd. and go south for 1.6 miles until C $\frac{1}{2}$ Rd. Turn right on C $\frac{1}{2}$ Rd. and travel 0.2 miles until the road ends. Park on the south shoulder.

Regulations:

Chapter P-01

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- D. Pear Park Section
 - 1. No boats, rafts or other floating devices of any kind shall be permitted on lakes between 30 Road and 29 Road.
 - 2. Only waterfowl hunting permitted in the areas and at the times posted. All other hunting prohibited.
 - 3. Only shotguns loaded with birdshot may be

- used for waterfowl hunting.
- 4. Reservations are required to hunt in accordance with #504.I.
- 5. Waterfowl hunting from designated blinds only.

Chapter W-05

- 1. Waterfowl hunting on the 34 Road Parcel is prohibited, except on Saturdays and Sundays. A reservation is required to hunt. Reservations must be made in accordance with #504.I of these regulations.
- 2. Hunters may only hunt the areas reserved and must park in designated areas. Hunters may only hunt from designated blinds, with a maximum of two (2) hunters per blind on the 34 Road Parcel and four (4) hunters per blind on the remainder of the state park.

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
