Park Passes and Prices

Annual Park Passes are valid from month of purchase for 1 year.

- Annual Affixed Vehicle Pass \$80
- Annual Hang Tag Pass \$120
(This pass is issued to an individual, not a vehicle, allowing individual to use to enter any Colorado state park as long as the owner is in the vehicle)
- Multiple Pass \$40
(Can be purchased with vehicle registrations that have the same address & receipt from \$80 annual pass purchase)
- Aspen Leaf Pass \$70
(Can be purchased by Colorado residents 64 and older)
- Aspen Leaf Multiple \$35
(Can be purchased with vehicle registrations that have the same address & receipt from \$70 Aspen Leaf pass purchase)
- Columbine Pass \$14
(Can be purchased by Permanently Disabled only at Regional Offices)
- Centennial Pass \$14
(Can be purchased by Lower Income Residents only at Regional Offices)
- Daily Park Passes \$9 per vehicle per day

Camper Information at Rifle Gap State Park



General Information

1. Keep all vehicles on road.
2. Keep campfires safe and attended at all times. Put fires out when leaving or sleeping.
3. Firewood gathering is prohibited. Firewood is available at the Visitor Center or from the Camp Hosts.
4. Quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
5. Pets must be leashed, picked up after and attended at all times.
6. Do not release gray water or sewage onto the ground. There is a dump station available by Cottonwood Camp Ground.
7. Only one family or group of not more than six people per campsite.
8. Only one camping unit per campsite.

A camping unit consists of:

- a. One passenger vehicle and two tents.
- b. One passenger vehicle towing one camping trailer and one tent.
- c. One motorized camper towing one camping trailer and one tent.

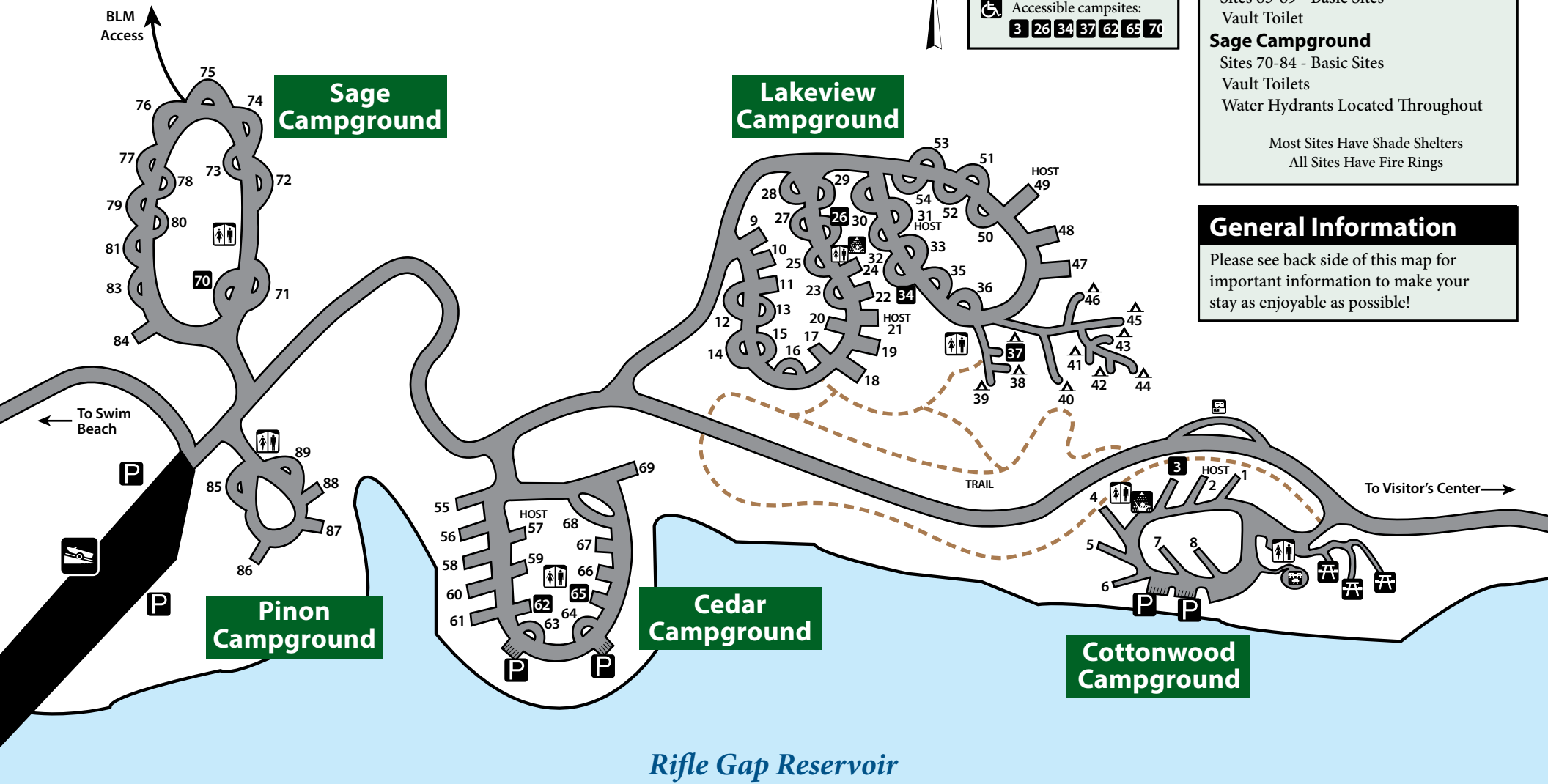
