# Roxborough State Park

## Who we are

Roxborough State Park is a designated National Natural Landmark, a State Natural Area, a National Archeological District, and an Audubon Important Bird Area. The park has also been recognized as a Leave No Trace Gold Standard Site by the Center for Outdoor Ethics. More than 1.2 billion years of geologic history can be seen in the park's stunning red-rock formations. The park has high biodiversity due to its location in a transition zone between the plains and the mountains. The area's geological structure encourages microclimates that include seven distinct plant communities in a unique mixture of prairie and mountain species. As a result, Roxborough is home to abundant wild-life, including black bear, mountain lion and deer. Spectacular sightseeing, tranquil surroundings and fascinating trails offer hiking, snow-shoeing and excellent educational programs on Colorado history, geology and wildlife.



- Continued housing construction in Douglas County, which is placing increased visitor demands on park resources through increased visitation
- Managing the park to preserve its natural, scenic and historic values, while trying to maximize revenues with limited recreational opportunities
- Addressing public requests for broader recreational activities, such as horseback and mountain bike riding

### Volunteer activities

- Among other activities, volunteers help to rehabilitate trails, eradicate non-native species and observe raptors as a part of the Statewide Raptor Monitoring Program.
